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## **List of Abbreviations**

**ACA:** Affordable Care Act.

**LA:** Limited Availability. This prescription may be available only at certain pharmacies. For more information, please call Customer Service.

**OTC:** Over the Counter. An OTC drug is a non-prescription drug.

**PA:** Prior Authorization. The Plan requires you or your physician to get prior authorization for certain drugs. This means that you will need to get approval before you fill your prescriptions. If you don't get approval, we may not cover the drug.

**QL:** Quantity Limit. For certain drugs, the Plan limits the amount of the drug that we will cover.

**ST:** Step Therapy. In some cases, the Plan requires you to first try certain drugs to treat your medical condition before we will cover another drug for that condition. For example, if Drug A and Drug B both treat your medical condition, we may not cover Drug B unless you try Drug A first. If Drug A does not work for you, we will then cover Drug B.
